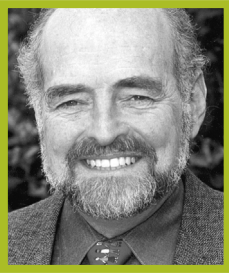

Proposition A: Yes

Proposition G: Yes
